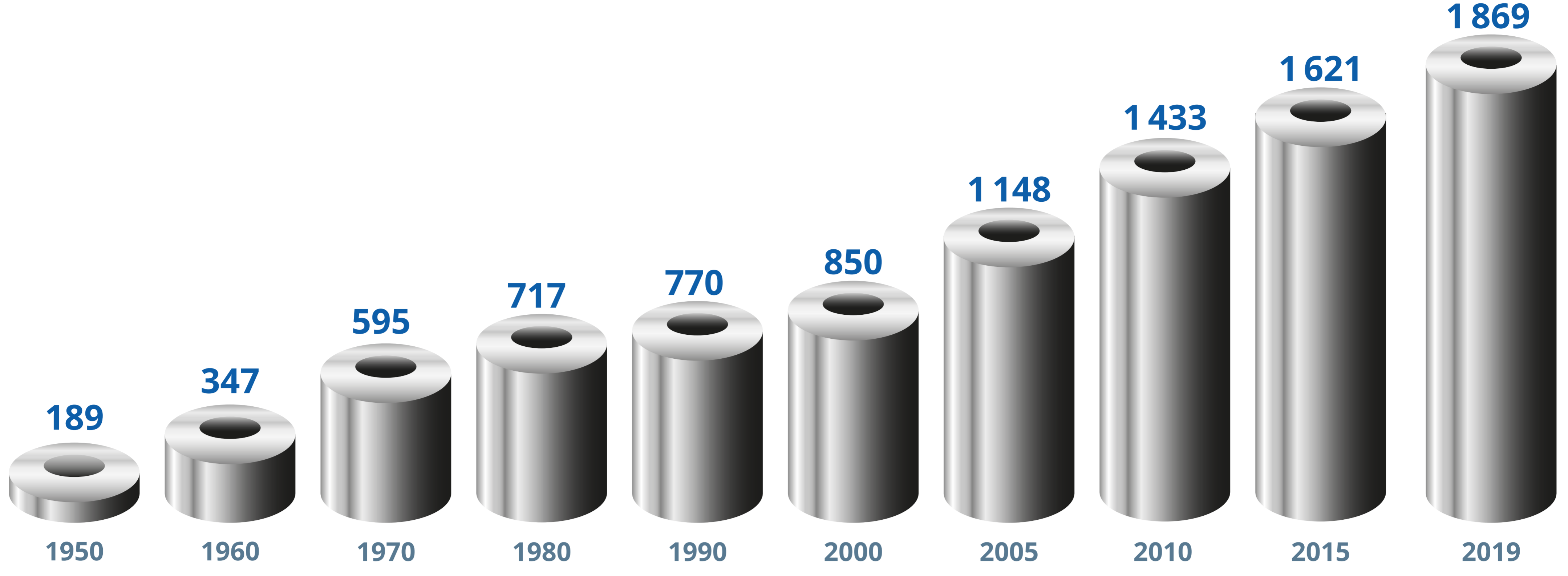


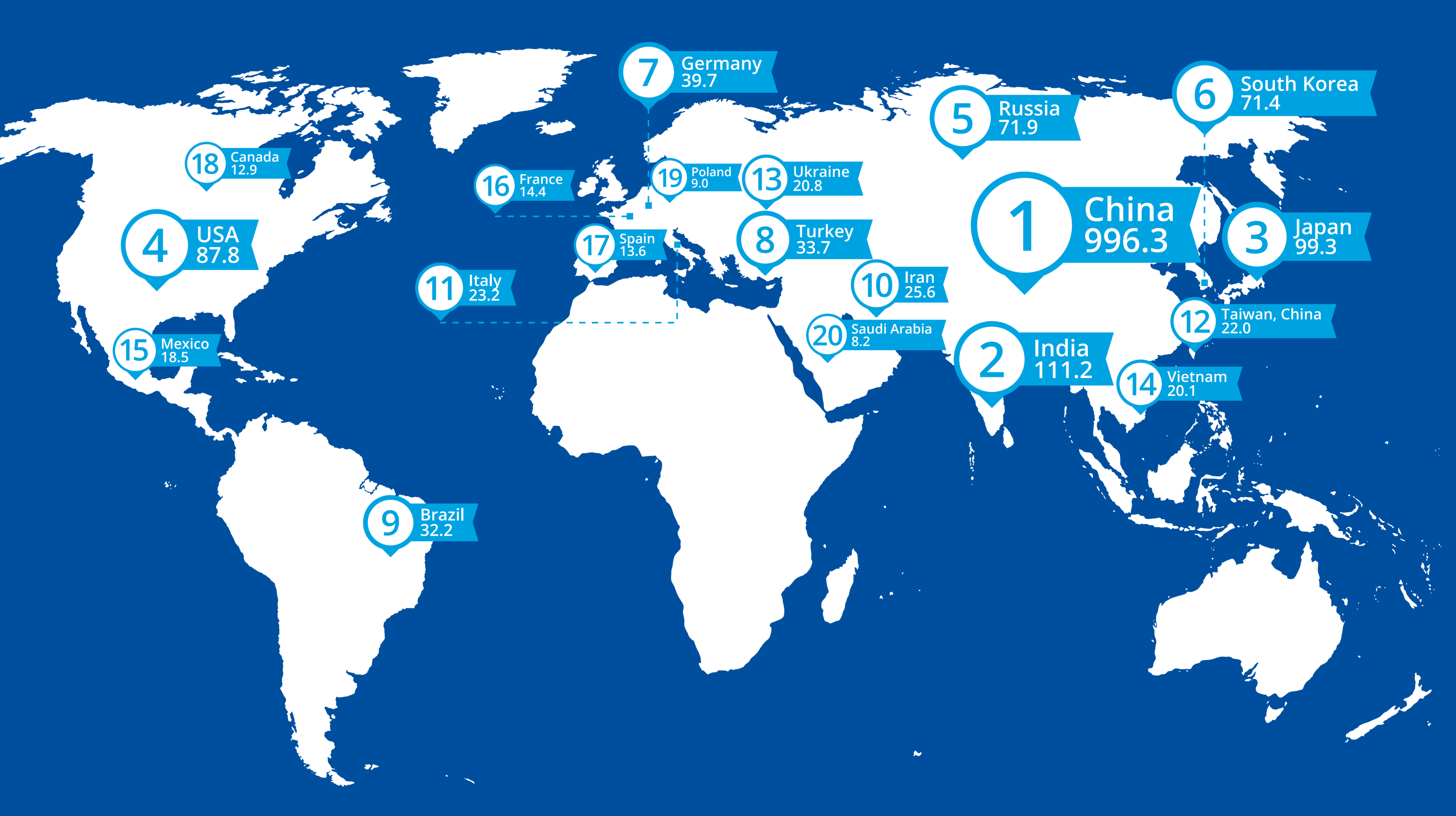

World crude steel production 1950 to 2019 (million tonnes)



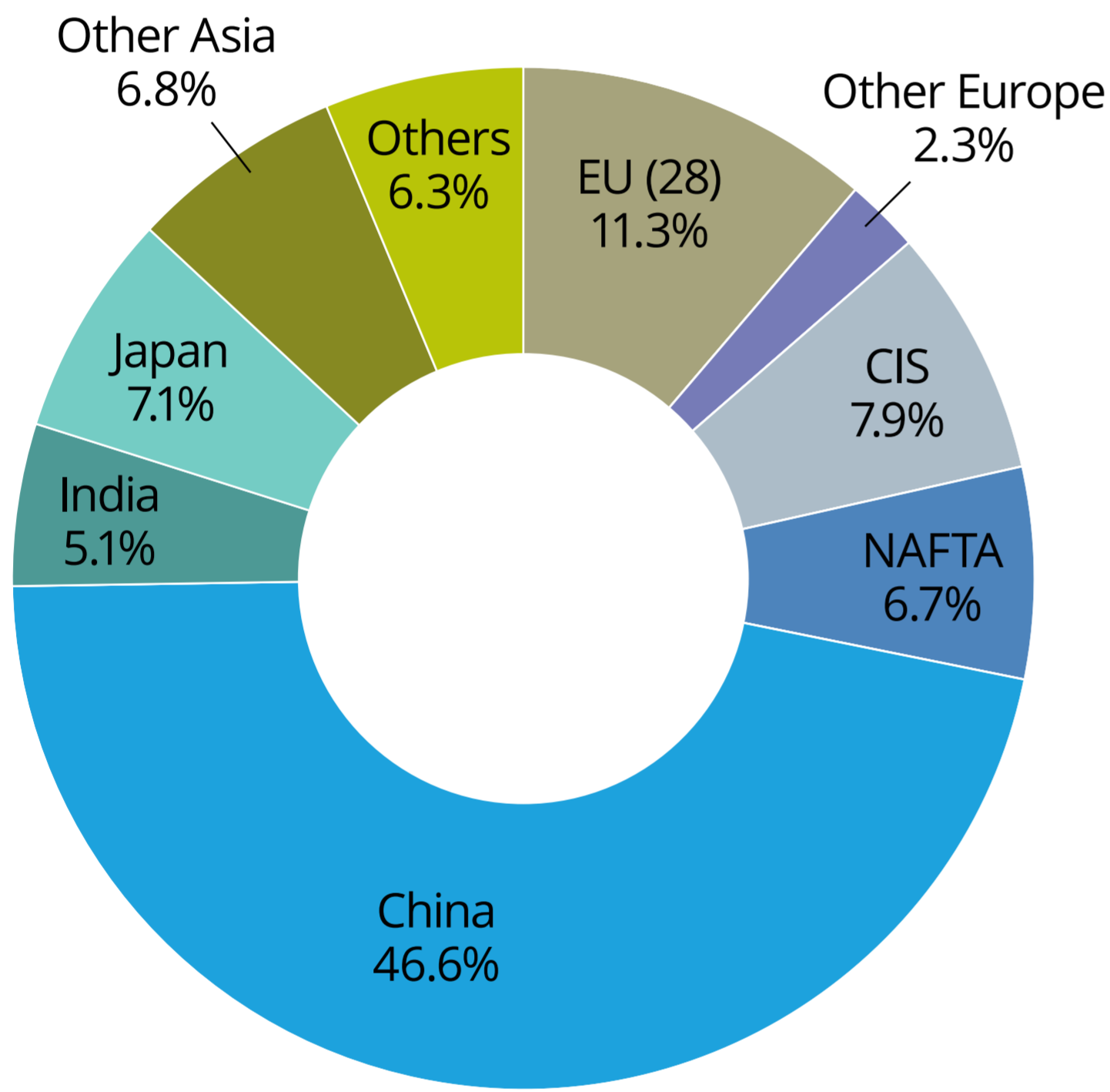
Top 20 steel-producing countries 2019 (million tonnes)

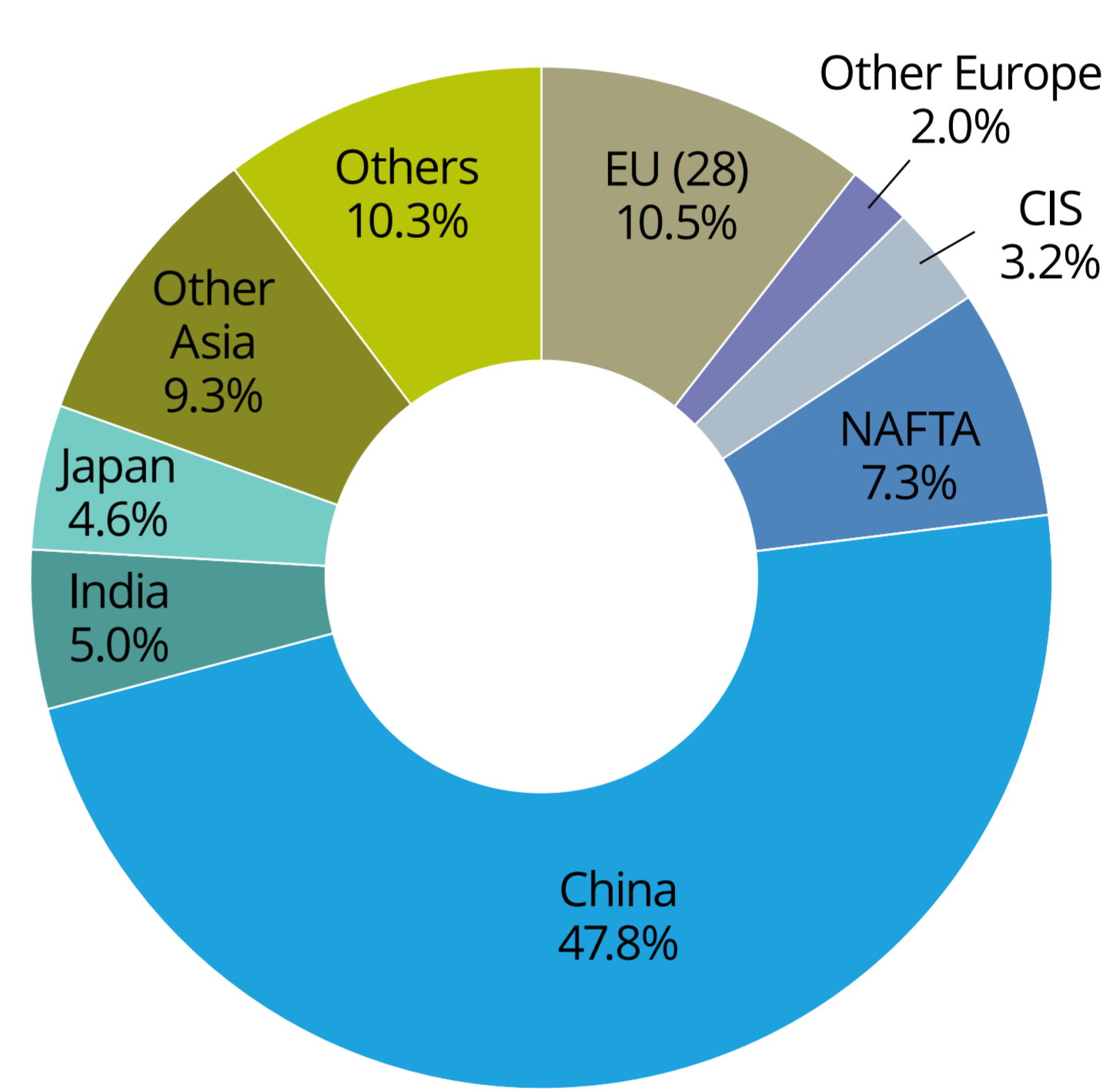

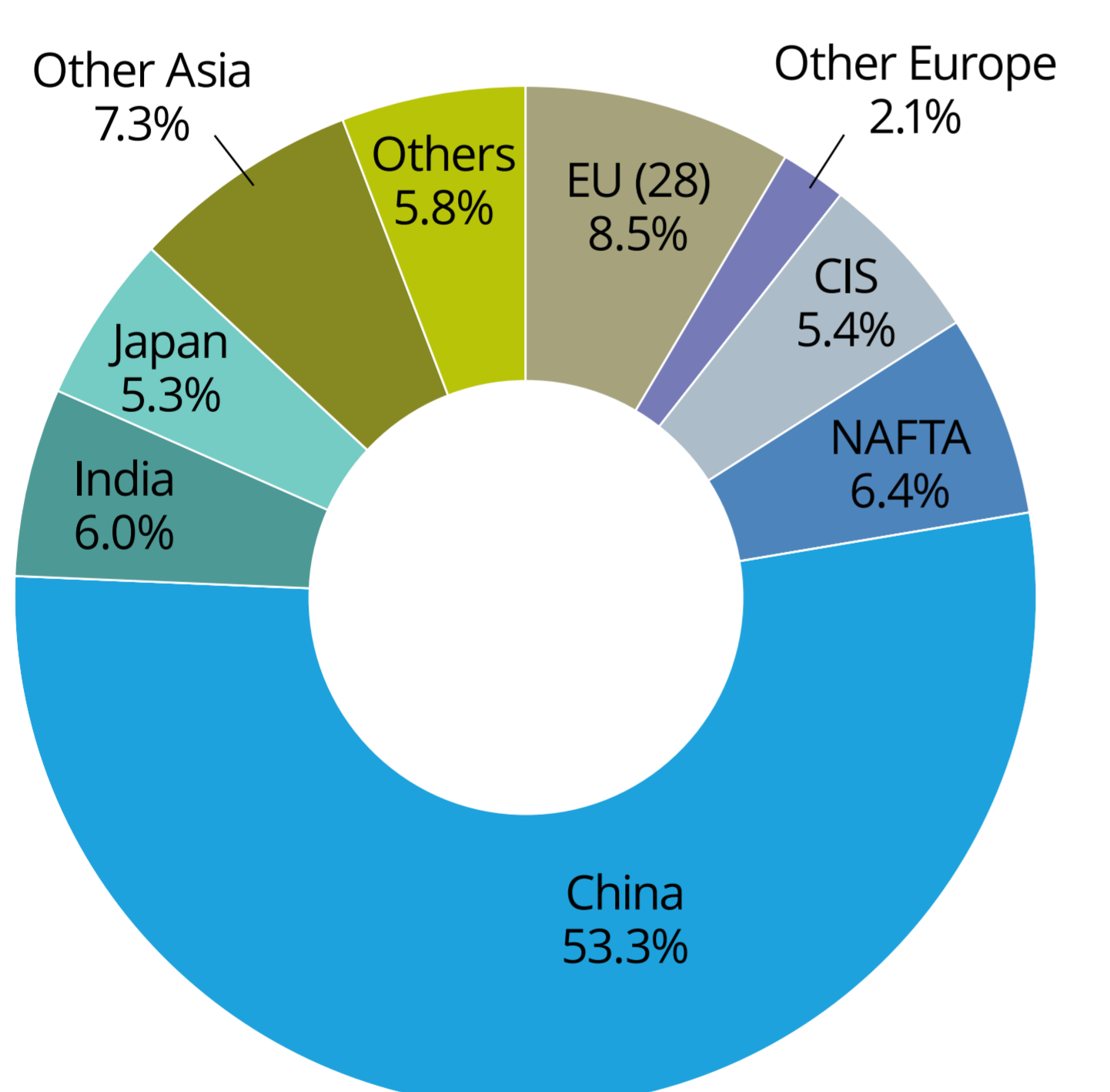

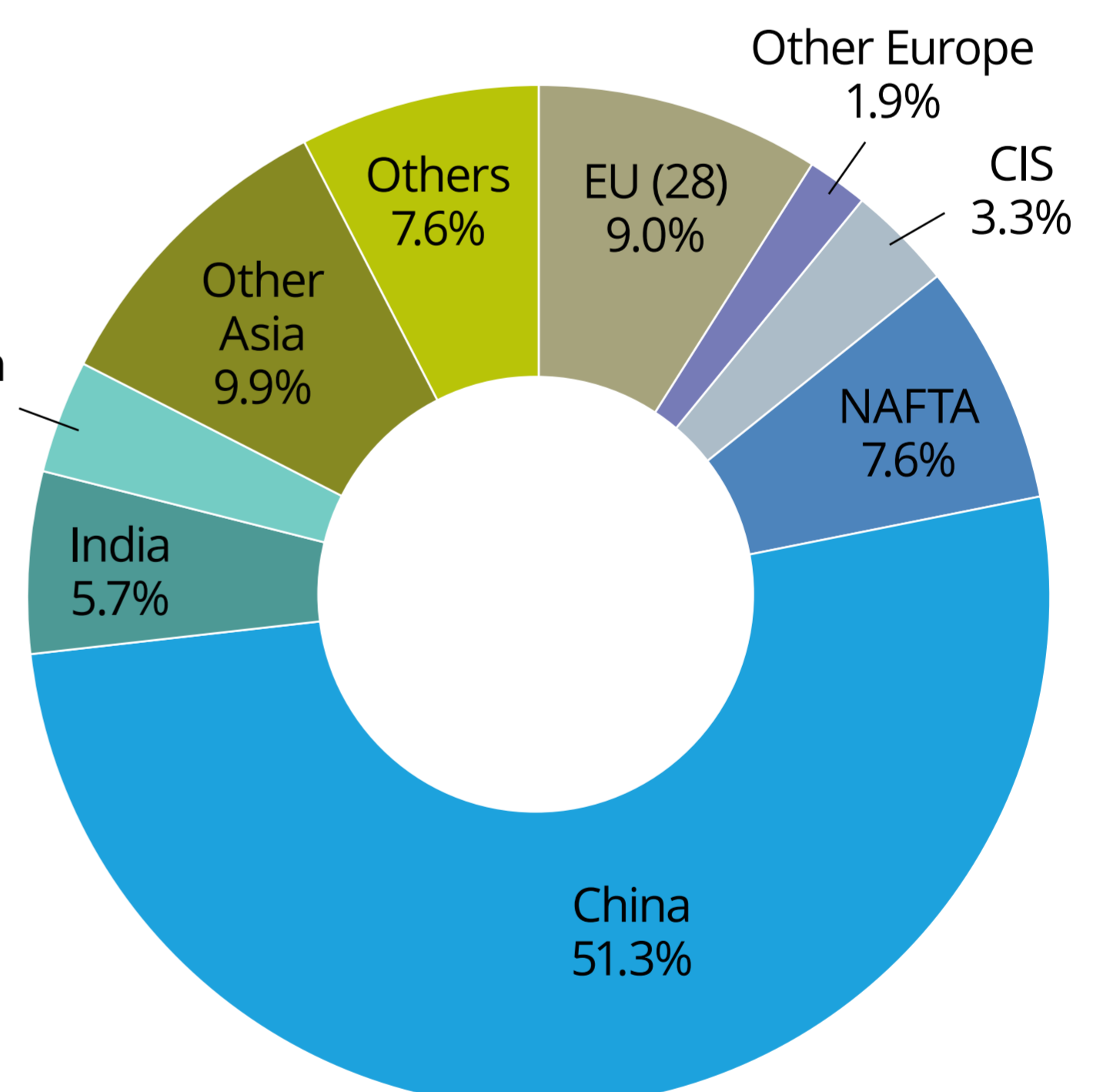
